PADDY SOWING AREA TILL 26/8 IS AT 384.05 LAKH HA

Paddy sowing area till August 26th reached at 384.05 lakh hectares in the place of 367.83 lakh hectares in the previous season, which is up by 4.41% or 16.23 lakh hectares. Total kharif sowing area is at 1053.59 lakh hectares as against 1049.96 lakh hectares in the previous year as per NSFM data.

TOTAL PULSES SOWING AREA IS AT 117.44 LAKH HECTARES

Total pulses sowing areas touched to 117.44 lakh hectares in the place of 128.07 lakh hectares during last year. Arhar or Tur sowing area is at 42.11 lakh hectares as against 44.38 lakh hectares in the same period of last year as on 26.8.2023. Urad sowing area is at 31.10 lakh hectares in the same period of last year. Moong sowing area is at 30.64 lakh hectares in the place of 33.34 lakh hectares in the same period of last year. Other pulses area at 13.34 lakh hectares as against 14.04 lakh hectares in the same period of last year as per NSFM data.

TOTAL COARSE CEREALS SOWING AREA AT 178.33 L.H TILL 26TH AUGUST

Total coarse cereals sowing area is at 178.33 lakh hectares in the place of 176.31 lakh hectares in the same period of last year. Maize sowing area touched to 82.09 lakh hectares (79.99 lakh hectares last year), Jower is at 13.84 lakh hectares (last year 14.99 lakh hectares) Bajra is at 70 lakh hectares (last year 69.32 lakh hectares). Ragi sowing area is at 7.63 lakh hectares in the place of 7.46 lakh hectares in the same period of last year as per NSFM data.

TOTAL OILSEEDS SOWING AREA REACHED TO 188.58 L.H TILLAUG 26

Total Oil seeds kharif sowing area is at 188.56 lakh hectares as against 190.38 lakh hectares in the same period of last year. Soyabean is at 124.71 lakh hectares in the place of 123.60 lakh hectares during the same period of last year. Sunflower is at 0.67 lakh hectares in the place of 1.89 lakh hectares in the same period of last year. Groundnut is at 43.27 lakh hectares (last year 44.75 lakh hectares). Malaysian palm oil futures on 25th August up by 2.11% or RM82 to RM3963 (\$ 854.46) on stonger vegetable oils, despite weak export data as per news sources. Hot and dry weather in U.S likley to effect Soyabean out and likely China's demand are supporting factores. Malayasian Palm oil exports for 1-25 August is seen falling 4.3% and 7.8% from last months corresponding period according to Cargo surveyors report.

BROILER CHICKEN PRICE LOST Rs.13 IN 5 DAYS DUE TO SLOW DEMAND

Broiler prices in Namakal, Palladam and Erode areas has been lost Rs.13 in 5 days due to reduction in purchase price and catching of chickens. Farm purchase price is fixed daily by Broiler Co-ordinating Committee (BCC) at palladam. Due to Shravana festivals, demand and consumption is fallen in the states of Andrapradesh, Karnataka. Due to fall in demand, prices have been lost according to the news sources.

CHICKEN AND EGG PRICES LIKELY TO RISE FROM SEPTEMBER

Poultry products such as Chicken and Egg prices likley to increase from September as demand is likley to increase after dietory restrictions of 2 months in Shravana. Sales have been lower by 15 to 20% in North and West India during July and August according to the news sources. Raw materials and feeds(maize) prices are increasing. Demand for chicken and eggs likley to pick up from next month.
